



What is it?

The Mountain Moon Festival is a cooperative weekend of music and dance—a place where we can come together, share what we know, learn something new, and have a lot of fun. Everyone helps by doing a chore (cooking, cleaning, etc.). Chores are a way of making the festival a community effort and help us to keep the cost down. They provide a great opportunity for getting to know people better and making new friends.

Family Co-op

If you choose to bring your children to the Moon Festival, you must either sign them up for the Family Co-op, or else be responsible for supervising them at all times. The Family Co-op (for 4-15 years old) is run by the parents and an organizing committee. During adult workshops and dances, the Co-op provides children's activities and a supervised sleeping area. Co-op parents are expected to lead a one-hour children's activity or workshop during the weekend.

Costs

Only **\$100** per adult (plus one chore) for the whole weekend,
\$50 per child 4-15 years of age,
free for tots 3 and under.
Everyone must be registered,
including the little ones, free or not.

Accommodations

Accommodations are coed, dorm style, cabins (first come, first served) or bring a tent for camping.

What to Bring

Musical instruments, songs, your laughter, dancing shoes, a sleeping bag and pillow, a coffee mug, warm clothes, the children, and other necessary personal items. No pets allowed.

Workshops

People who attend can offer workshops in whatever interests them. Examples in the past include Beginning Waltz, Beginning Old Timey Music, Lindy Hop, Stargazing, Fireside Singalong, Celtic Jam, Yoga, Cooking, and Art Projects. To offer a workshop, you don't have to have a professional level of expertise, just a willingness to share what you know with others.
